For vehicles sold in any of the states that follow California Air Resources Board (CARB) rules, 10 years or 150,000 miles of coverage is required for the battery, be it in a hybrid, plug-in hybrid ...

A standard battery warranty should come with at least 10 years of protection, though it can be shorter depending on how often you charge and drain your battery. Battery warranties typically won't reimburse for labor costs associated with installing new equipment or shipping fees for new equipment.

Companies typically reflect this fact in their warranties - as shown by AlphaESS's 10-year warranty on its SMILE-G3-S5 battery, or GivEnergy's 12-year warranty on the Giv-Bat 5.2. Some warranties also include the number of cycles a battery performs - that is, the amount of times it charges up and discharges.

Additionally, you can see if the performance-management feature, which dynamically manages maximum performance to prevent unexpected shutdowns, is on, and you can choose to turn it off.
