First, make sure you"ve measured and re-measured where your cabinet is going. You"ll use these dimensions to build the face frame. For my face frame I used ¾ maple, but poplar is also a popular choice and option for face frames. After you"ve cut your frame pieces to size, I find the best method is to assemble with pocket holes and wood.
